Part	Definition	Examples
	Underground part of the plant that doesn't have buds or leaves	
	Colorful and fragrant part of a plant found in flowering plants	
	Slender and elongated plant part that supports the upper part of the plant	
	Above-ground part of plant that conducts photosynthesis	
	Seed bearing part of the plant which is often edible and colorful	
	Small embryonic plant which has stored food and is enclosed in a covering
